



## **ORDERING INSTRUCTIONS FOR SECURIFY ESI BPA # FA8771-06-A-0303**

The Department of the Air Force on behalf of the DoD Enterprise Software Initiative and Patriot Technologies, Inc. entered into a Department of Defense (DOD) Enterprise Software Agreement for the Securify line of Network Security Management products in support of the DOD's Information Assurance initiatives.

Under the agreement, DOD agencies and their authorized contractors may purchase Securify products under the agreed Enterprise Software Initiative schedule. Annual maintenance for these products is also included on the schedule.

**The effective date of the BPA is January 5, 2006.**

*Notice to ordering offices:* Ordering via this BPA is decentralized. The BPA award has been determined to be the best value to the Government and, therefore, competition is not required for software, software maintenance and other fixed priced services. All services are based on the published hourly rates and must be accompanied by a Statement of Work (SOW) from Securify/Patriot. Orders are to be prepared by a Government Ordering Officer (a duly warranted Contracting Officer whose warrant authorizes purchases from the GSA schedule), in accordance with the terms and conditions of this BPA and the GSA schedule. Orders may be placed by EDI, Credit Card, facsimile, or an authorized government form.

### **PRICING**

The BPA Securify pricing is based on Patriot's GSA schedule and offers accelerated discounts for volume purchases. Please reference the attached spreadsheet for pricing, all pricing includes appropriate GSA/BPA fees. All orders must be accompanied by a BPA quote from Patriot Technologies. *Note that the BPA fee will be shown as a separate line item on Patriot quotes and invoices.*

### **QUOTING / ORDERING CONTACT INFORMATION**

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## GOVERNMENT POINTS OF CONTACT

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## DFARS DIRECTIVES

DFARS Section 208.74 directs DoD software buyers and requiring officials to check the DoD ESI website for DoD inventory or an ESA before using another method of acquisition. These steps for the buyer are summarized from the DFARS:

- a) Check the Enterprise Agreement Summary Table to determine if software rights or maintenance have already been purchased and are available from DoD inventory. If they are available, purchase the designated software from DoD inventory and reimburse the SPM.
- b) If the required software rights or maintenance are not available from inventory or from an ESA, you may use an alternate method of acquisition, subject to laws and policy.
- c) If the required software rights or maintenance are not available from inventory but are available from an ESA, you must follow the procedure in the DFARS Section 208.74.
- d) If you must obtain the software or software maintenance outside the DoD ESA, you may seek a waiver from a management official designated by your DoD Component.
